### Drug Abuse

An officer stopped a vehicle driven by male who was showing criminally revoked. He was initially arrested for misdemeanor bail jumping and criminal operating while revoked. Through investigation a probable cause search of the vehicle yielded methamphetamine, THC, a scale with methamphetamine residue on it, and smoking device with THC residue. He was additionally charged with the following: felony intent to distribute methamphetamine, felony intent to distribute marijuana and misdemeanor possession of drug paraphernalia. While at the Jail, he changed prior to being booked and staff located three clear zip-style baggies with crystal like substances and one clear baggie containing multiple clear smaller baggies.

### Car vs Pedestrian Crash

Report of a car vs. pedestrian accident. Upon arrival, Officers located the pedestrian lying on his back on N Bridge Street, near the middle of the roadway, unresponsive with agonal breathing. Officers checked for a pulse and located one, but he would not respond. He was bleeding from the head. EMS stabilized and transported the pedestrian. Wisconsin State Patrol was requested for a reconstruction.

### Drug Abuse

An officer conducted a traffic stop with a vehicle driven by a female who had an expired driver's license. Officers observed a flask in the vehicle. Officers discovered the flask was empty and the driver was warned about her bond conditions regarding alcohol possession and consumption.

Through further investigation officers searched the vehicle and located a blue glass pipe and a spice bottle with a leafy green substance which tested presumptively positive for THC. A gem pack with white residue was located in back pocket of the driver's seat. The residue tested presumptively positive for meth. Knives were also located which was a violation of her felony bond conditions. She was taken to jail.

**OWI 5<sup>th</sup>**

Officers stopped a vehicle for a headlamp out. Field Sobriety tests were conducted and he was arrested for OWI-5th Offense, and cited for THC prohibited.
