Domestic Disturbance

Caller requested officers to remove his girlfriend from the residence as they were in a verbal altercation. Officers were advised she was locked in the bathroom. She was screaming when officers arrived and attempted to lock herself in a bedroom. She was arrested for Disorderly Conduct, Resisting or Obstructing an Officer, and Battery or Threat to LE and cited for Underage Drinking. After she left, the caller said he hit and pushed her. He was arrested for Disorderly Conduct with the Domestic Abuse Enhancer.

Check Person

Complainant reported two people were in a boat in the flooded Riverfront Park. The area was checked and no boat was observed. It was a concern due to how high the water levels were and the swift current. Images were later seen of an individual in a small fishing boat.

Domestic Disturbance

Officers responded to an address for the report of a male breaking into the residence and punching a female. The female said that the male came into her room swearing and demanded her phone. She tried to get her phone back, but he began shoving her. A second female saw this and tried to defend her friend because she is pregnant. The male threw her to the ground and started punching her in the face causing her to have a bump on her head. Another male at the residence tried to help the women, but he also was thrown to the ground and punched in the head. All parties were able to get up and run to another residence. The male broke the window to get into that residence and punched the female in the

head again. Domestic criteria was met. The male was arrested for damage to property, Domestic Disorderly Conduct x2, Domestic Battery x2 and Resisting officers.

Drug Abuse

Officers were called to the 600 block of Dutchman Dr for a report of a male subject slumped over the wheel in his vehicle. Officers arrived at the location. According to witnesses at the scene, the male had been driving on State St. swerving into oncoming traffic, ran through the stop sign at Court St, and ran into the fence at State St. The driver had put the vehicle in reverse and backed up and stopped and slumped over the wheel. Officers and EMS arrived and administered Narcan which revived the driver. He was placed into custody for OWI and a search of the vehicle was conducted. Fentanyl was located as well as a small marijuana joint. Officers continued investigation into the incident and were able to locate additional drugs and items of police interest on a second subject. The subject was referred to the DA's Office for charges of Possession of Methamphetamine, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Felon in Possession of OC.

Drug Abuse

Officers received a report of a road rage incident occurring on Park Avenue. The officer located the offending vehicle and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver was subsequently arrested for OWI 3rd, Possession of Cocaine, and Possession of THC.
