**Drug Abuse**

Officers were called to a hotel for the report of a male not wanting to leave the hotel room. Officers arrived and contacted with a male who stated he was sleeping. While leaving the hotel room, he was seen removing Busch Light cans from the fridge. He is on open felony bond not to possess alcohol. He was taken into custody and a search of his person was conducted. Cocaine was located on his person as well in the room. Items used to produce cocaine base was also located in the room. A K9 sniff of the male's motorcycle was conducted and a search of the vehicle was conducted. Two separate pills were located in the motorcycle. He was taken to jail.

**OWI**

Officer conducted a traffic stop due to the registered owner having a revoked license. Sign of impairment were observed and SFSTs were conducted. He was arrested for OWI (2nd), operating while revoked, possession of THC, possession of drug paraphernalia, warning for defective brake lamps. He was released to jail staff.
