Theft

Staff from a gas station reported someone stole \$430.23 worth of cigarettes. Staff had video of the suspect and suspect vehicle. Vehicle and suspect were identified. Staff wanted to pursue charges. Staff also wanted the two people the suspect was with to be notified they weren't allowed back to the store. The suspect wanted to pay for the cigarettes after being confronted about the video footage. The suspect came to the PD and was given bond sheet and referred for Theft.

Drug Abuse

Officer stopped a vehicle for operating left of center. During stop the driver showed signs of impairment and said he was traveling to look for tires from Kwik Trip to Walmart in Lake Hallie. SFST's conducted and he wasn't arrested for OWI. Cause was developed to search the vehicle and illicit drugs were located. He was taken into custody without issue for Possession of methamphetamine, drug paraphernalia, THC, and misdemeanor bail jumping.

OWI 4th with minor in vehicle

Officer observed a vehicle operate left of center with varying speeds. Operator was also was believed to be revoked. Officer initiated a traffic stop with the vehicle and detected intoxicants. SFSTs were conducted. The driver was arrested for OWI-4th w/minor passenger (seven years-old), operating while revoked and felony bail jumping. The juvenile was released to his father. DHS was notified of the call.

Drug Abuse

Caller reported she could hear a male yelling "why won't you sell me meth" at a residence. Contact was made with a male subject. He said a female acquaintance of his was at his house and they began verbally fighting. He said she threw a hammer at him but missed. He did not want to pursue charges. While in contact, a glass smoking device with a burnt residue suspected to be meth was located in plain view along with other misc. drug paraphernalia. Charges for possession of meth and possession of drug paraphernalia will be referred for the male subject.
