Drug Abuse

Officers responded to this address for an unresponsive male. Officer administered Narcan and he came-to shortly after EMS arrived. The man denied using any illegal narcotics but admitted to drinking Twisted Tea. A probation search was conducted and Fentanyl, Methamphetamine, and drug paraphernalia were located. Officers also located evidence of drug dealing. He was arrested for possession with intent to deliver, possession of methamphetamine and possession of drug paraphernalia. A probation hold was also placed.

Assault

Caller reported her teenage daughter assaulted her and left the residence after an argument. During the argument the caller alleged her daughter hit her multiple times and put a hole in her grandmother's door. The daughter was taken into custody at Subway and taken to the Juvenile Detention Center. Charges for Disorderly Conduct, criminal damage, battery, and underage tobacco will be referred to juvenile intake.

OWI

Officer observed a vehicle traveling on W Park Ave turn into the parking lot at America's Best Value Inn and hit a snow bank. The driver stepped out of the vehicle, walked around it, tried to repark it and hit the snowbank again. The officer suspected impaired driving and conducted SFSTs. The driver was arrested for OWI-1st Offense.

OWI Crash

Officers responded to a report of two car crash Peck St/W Columbia St. Both drivers stated that one vehicle was driving south on Peck and did not yield to the other vehicle driving east on Columbia. One driver displayed signs of impairment and SFST was

completed. He was taken into custody for OWI 4th, felony bail jumping, and cited for fail to yield at stop sign.
