Assist EMS

Officers responded to the above location for a female in active labor. Upon arrival on scene the child was born and crying. Chippewa Falls EMS arrived on scene and advised CFPD was no longer needed.

Warrant

Officers responded for an evaluation of a male. Northwest Connections evaluated and determined he did not need to be chaptered. He had a valid warrant through P&P and was arrested on it. Upon arrival at the jail, officers found a bayonet and a BB gun in his backpack. He was additionally charged with carrying a conceal knife due to being a convicted felon. The knife has been entered into evidence. The BB gun has been placed into the lost and found for him to pick up.

Drug Abuse

Officers were dispatched to the residence for a report of a possible domestic. Contact was made with the complainant who advised he heard a male yelling and observed a female leave the residence. Officers spoke to both who denied an altercation had occurred. The male was breaking items of his own and he was arrested and released for Disorderly Conduct and Possession of THC. A probation search was conducted and the female was subsequently arrested for Possession of Methamphetamine, Possession of THC, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Misdemeanor Bail Jumping and a Probation Violation. Later, the male was arrested for Possession of Methamphetamine, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

Disorderly Conduct

School Resource Officers responded for an elementary grade student who was throwing items in a classroom and trying to barricade a door. Prior to their arrival the student was able to calm down and return to his special education classroom. The student's teacher contacted the mother and a plan was put into place.

Animal Complaint

Caller reported a deceased armadillo in the roadway in front of an establishment. Officers arrived and did locate an actual armadillo, deceased in the roadway. Officers disposed of the armadillo.

Animal Complaint

Caller stated there was an injured duck in the Romeis Apartments' parking lot. Upon arrival, the officer found a full-sized goose in the parking lot. The goose appeared uninjured and was directed out of the parking lot.

OWI Armed While Intoxicated

Traffic stop for failure to stop for traffic signal. The driver was suspected to be under the influence. The officer saw a pistol and an open intoxicant in the vehicle. The driver was eventually arrested for OWI and being armed while intoxicated.

Threats

A student reported a high school student made a comment about killing himself with a gun and had access to guns in his home. School Resource Officer contacted the mother and advised her of the complaint. The mother advised there is not access to firearms in the residence and that she would follow up with her son.

Check Person

Kwik Trip staff reported a female who needed help due to not having anywhere to go. Contact was made with the female who stated that she was with a friend when he "wiggled out" and she did not want to stay with him. She requested help in finding a phone charger to contact a ride to get out of town. With her limited resources, she was transported to the police department and borrowed a charger.

Drug Abuse

An officer located a vehicle running in the parking lot with the lights off. When the officer stepped out with the vehicle he observed a man he knew had warrants. A female then exited the nearby store and the man identified her with a fake name. The female was stopped and detained and identified herself. The officer learned she also had a warrant. A probation search was completed of her property and methamphetamine was located. The man was taken to jail for the warrant. The female was taken to jail for the warrant as well as possession of methamphetamine, and possession of paraphernalia.
