Domestic Assault with a weapon

Officers responded to possible domestic. Caller stated a male subject had her cornered in the bathroom and he had a knife. Officers responded and made entry into the residence. Subjects were ordered out of the residence. A male exited but did not comply with officer's orders and a taser was deployed. After a brief struggle the male was taken into custody. He was arrested for domestic related disorderly conduct, reckless endangering safety and resisting.

Drug Abuse

Officer conducted a traffic stop for defective lighting. During initial contact, the odor of marijuana was detected emanating from the vehicle and a search was conducted. During the search, a total of 46.6 G of meth was located as well as fentanyl, LSD, Cocaine base, marijuana, schedule II pills, and psilocybin. Both the driver and passenger were taken into custody for multiple drug charges.

Battery to Law Enforcement, Discharging Bodily Fluids, Felony Bail Jumping

Officers responded to the above area for a report of a female screaming and laying on the ground. Contact was made with a female who was walking in the area. Officers spoke with her. She was intoxicated and appeared to be under the influence of a stimulant. Her behavior was consistent with recent methamphetamine usage. Officers determined she was in violation of her bond to maintain absolute sobriety and she was placed under arrest for felony bail jumping. During the arrest and subsequent medical clearance she spat on and kicked officers. She was

arrested for Felony Bail Jumping x4, battery to law enforcement, discharge bodily fluids, and obstruction.

OWI 3rd

Caller reported a vehicle was swerving, almost struck another car, and was traveling really slow. Officers located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. SFST' s were conducted and the driver was arrested for OWI-3rd.
