**Domestic Abuse & OWI**

Officers responded to speak to a complainant about a domestic assault that had occurred. Officers were advised that the complainant had gotten into a verbal dispute with her boyfriend and had called friends for a ride away. Those friends came armed with a shotgun. The friends took the complainant away and called 911. The boyfriend was located and had driven the complainant's vehicle into a ditch. The boyfriend was arrested for OWI. One of the complainant's friends was referred to the DA for pulling the shotgun on the boyfriend.

**Bar Fight**

Officers responded to a tavern for a report of a fight. It was reported that a patron was being rude to the bartender so she told him to leave. He refused and when another patron stepped between them he threw them against the wall and punched him in the head. The patron left, but has been identified. He will be referred for Disorderly Conduct, battery, and misdemeanor bail jumping.

**Warrant, Resisting and Theft**

Officers observed a male known to have a warrant walking downtown. A records check confirmed he had a Wisconsin Department of Corrections warrant. Contact was made. He resisted officers by tensing and attempting to pull away. He was eventually placed under arrest. The officer discovered he had a ribeye steak and bacon stuffed into his pants. He was taken to Chippewa County Jail for the warrant and resisting/obstructing an officer. Officers checked and learned the food had been stolen from Kwik Trip. He was referred for theft.
