### Fraud

Caller reported he had all his money taken from his bank account. Called advised he had spoken with "customer service" the day before and they had him change all his information to the account. The investigating officer called the phone number and determined it was a fake phone number. The caller was shown how to get the actual Chime customer support number and told to call their fraud department. He was provided his options.

### Fraud

Juvenile caller reported a scammer altered a picture of him to make it look like he sent a nude photograph from the waist down and were threatening to send it to his family/friends if he did not send them gift cards. Caller and his mother met with CFPD Sensitive Crimes investigator. Caller had deleted the photos. They were provided with options and resources.

### Drug Abuse Overdose

Report of an unresponsive male subject near Spring Street and Grove Street with CPR in progress. Upon arrival, officers noticed agonal breathing and administered Narcan which was effective. The patient was identified. Officer conducted a probation search of the residence and located a tear-off bag with an unknown white powder, two suspected THC pipes, a rubber container with roaches, and .6 G of THC in a grinder were located. Probation was notified and a hold was placed.

**Assist EMS**

Officers and EMS were called to Irvine Park for two juveniles who fell off a cliff on the side of the walking path. Officers arrived and assisted EMS until no longer needed. Both juveniles were transported. No foul play was suspected in the incident.
