The other operator was cited for unreasonable and imprudent speed, passing in a no passing zone, OAR Civil and operating a motor vehicle without insurance.

Drug Abuse

Officers responded for a lady trying to steal a bicycle then banging on random doors and windows. She appeared to be under the influence however denied any drug use. She provided Officers with multiple false last names. She also entered an apartment and demanded water/soda. The apartment resident does not know her and did not want her in his residence. During the contact she kept talking about being with a Girl Scout troop and seeing things that were not there. Officers were able to search her bag and a bubble fell out that tested positive for methamphetamine. She was arrested for obstruction, felony bail jumping, trespass to a dwelling, disorderly conduct, possession of methamphetamine, and a probation hold.
