Drug Abuse

An RV and a van with no plates were observed on the dead of E Canal St. Contact was made with a man who was fishing nearby. He arrived at the location and while speaking with officers dropped two gem bags of suspected methamphetamine. A search was conducted and a pipe was located. He was taken into custody for a probation violation, possession of illegally obtained prescription, possession of methamphetamine and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Drug Abuse

A consent contact was made with two females in a vehicle after seeing one roll a stop sign and pull into the gas station. The vehicle's registration was expired and the driver had a suspended Driver's License. The females switched seats prior to officers making contact with them. A silicone container was seen partially hanging out of one female's pant pocket, which she stated contained THC wax. A search was conducted and two corner ties with a white residue were located in the vehicle. She believed the powder was cocaine. Follow-up to be completed.

Death Investigation

Officers responded to the above area for an anonymous report of a bad smell in the area. The officer recognized the smell was potentially a decomposing body. Officers located the residence they thought the odor was originating from. Officers spoke with neighbors and they hadn't seen the resident in weeks and his vehicle was parked in front. Officers were unable to locate family and made entry into the residence. Officers located a decomposed body in the upstairs bedroom. Officers located several personal mail and ID that belonged to the resident. The family was notified. No foul play is suspected.
