#### Fraud

Caller reported an ongoing scam. She was attempting to sell a dress for \$30 online, when an email of "[apr61@gmail.com](mailto:apr61@gmail.com)" attempted to purchase it. The card declined and "April" sent the caller \$760 by "mistake". "April" had the caller cash the check and distribute it to various cash-app accounts. "April" was now requesting an additional \$100 from the caller, or "April" would send cult and gang members from Eau Claire to take her children. The caller was advised to no longer communicate with the email and to not send them any money. The caller will be sending over screenshots of the emails. Investigation continues.

#### Drug and Weapons

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle with no plates. Through investigation of the stop the driver was eventually arrested for Carry Concealed Knife, Felon in Possession of OC, Possession of Methamphetamine, Felony Bail Jumping, Possession of THC, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

#### Fraud

Caller reported fraud to her and her daughter when they gave money to her online boyfriend, who claimed to be in the Army so he could fly home to be with them. The male used the name "Robin Scott" and claimed he was arrested and hospitalized against his will and requested more money. Total loss was \$2,100 between the two of them. Most of the money was sent via gift

cards, but some will be given back by their bank. There is no further information about the male involved and the caller was informed it was a scam.
